# Helm Console

As of Artemis V1.70  
08-Jan-2013

The main Helm Console keyboard layout is organized as follows:

- Viewscreen Commands:** A bracketed group of function keys F1 through F8. F1 is labeled 'Help', F2 'Front', F3 'Left', F4 'Right', F5 'Rear', F6 'Tactical', F7 'Long Range', and F8 'Ship Status'. ESC is labeled 'Reverse Thrust'.
- Consoles:** A bracketed group of function keys F9 through F12. F9 is 'Previous' and F10 is 'Next'. F11 and F12 are unlabeled.
- Warp:** A bracketed group of number keys 1 through 4, labeled 'Warp 1' through 'Warp 4'. The tilde key (~) is also included.
- Other Function Keys:** Q is 'Toggle Shield', W is 'Impulse Up', T is 'Zoom In', Y is 'Zoom Out', K is 'Raise Shield', and L is 'Lower Shield'.
- Navigation/Control:** A, S, D are 'Rudder Left', 'Impulse Down', and 'Rudder Right' respectively. F, G, H, J, and Enter are also present.
- Standard Keyboard:** Includes Shift, Z, X, C, V, B, N, M, and other standard keys.
- Special Keys:** Ctrl, Win, Left Alt, Space (labeled 'All Stop (x2 if at warp)'), Right Alt, Win, Left Alt, Ctrl.



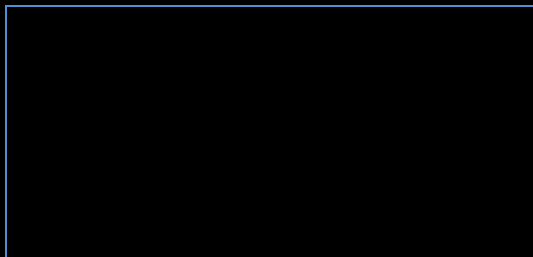
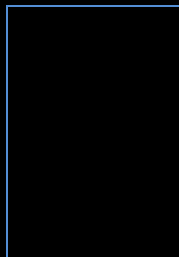
# Engineering Console

The main keyboard layout is organized into several functional sections:

- Function Row:** ESC, F1 (Help), F2, F3, F4, F5, F6, F7, F8, F9 (Consoles Previous), F10 (Consoles Next), F11, F12.
- Recall Energy and Coolant Presets:** A row of buttons labeled Preset 1 through Preset 10, corresponding to the numeric keys 1-0.
- Standard QWERTY Row:** Tab, Q, W (Power Up), E (Coolant Up), R, T, Y, U, I, O, P, {, }, | \.
- Second Row:** Caps Lock, A (Prev System), S (Power Down), D (Next System), F, G, H, J, K, L, ; ', Enter (Reset Coolant Levels).
- Third Row:** Shift, Z, X, C (Coolant Down), V, B, N, M, <, >, ?, Shift.
- Bottom Row:** Ctrl, Win, Left Alt, Space (Reset Energy Levels (x2) - Reset Coolant Levels), Right Alt, Win, Left Alt, Ctrl.



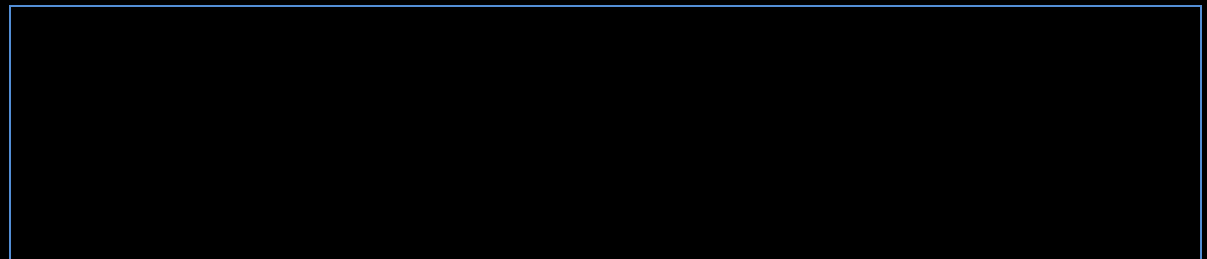
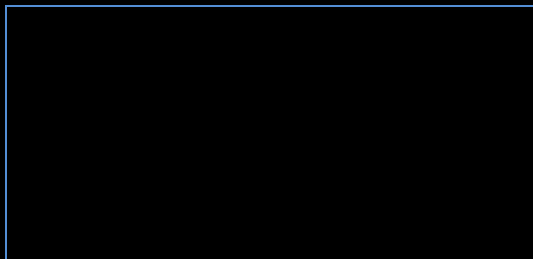
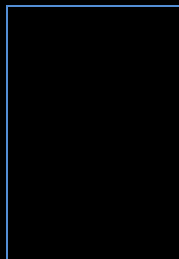
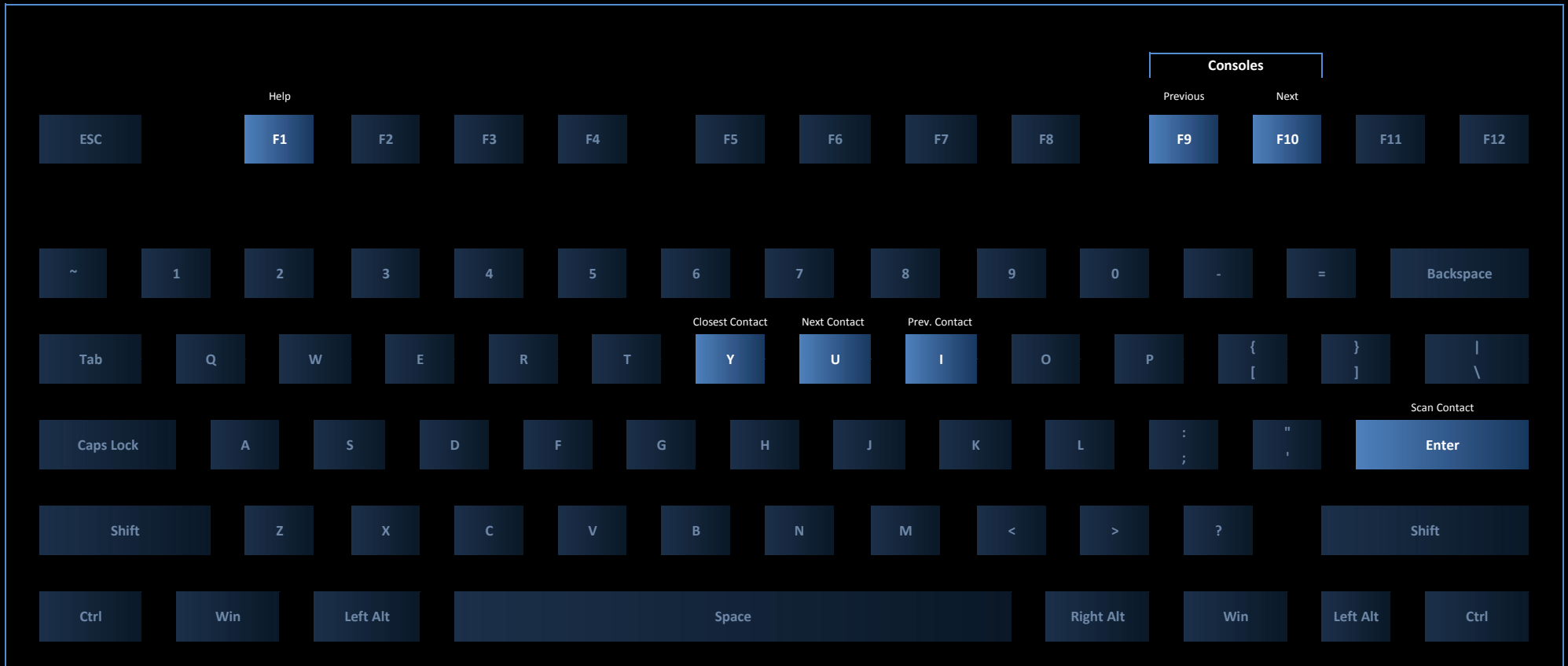
### Special Commands

- Row 2 (Communication Hotkeys):** ~, 1 (Select TX), 2 (Select TX), 3 (Select TX), 4 (Select TX), 5 (Select TX), 6 (Select TX), 7 (Select TX), 8 (Select TX), 9 (Select TX), 0 (Cancel), -, =, Backspace.
- Row 3:** Tab, Q, W, E, R, T, Y, U, I, O, P, {, }, | \.
- Row 4:** Caps Lock, A, S, D, F, G, H, J, K, L, :, ";, Enter.
- Row 5:** Shift, Z, X, C, V, B, N, M, <, >, ?, Shift.
- Row 6:** Ctrl, Win, Left Alt, Space, Right Alt, Win, Left Alt, Ctrl.
